



RACE REGULATIONS

Art.1 - Organisation:

On the anniversary of the Liberation, the association ASD Gruppo Sportivo A.N.P.I. Provinciale, Cod. Soc. 05F0236, sited in via E.Valentinis, 84 - 34074 Monfalcone (GO), Tel. 0481798098 Fax. 0481792229 e-mail race@coppamontes.eu in collaboration with Team Isonzo Ciclistica Pieris, with the sponsorship of the Provincial Committee of the A.N.P.I. of Gorizia and the Regional CONI, organizes an International event on Saturday 25 April 2026 the 71th edition of "Coppa Montes – Gran Premio della Resistenza" under the U.C.I. regulations .

Art.2 – Type of Event – Participation:

The race is listed on the UCI calendar – Class 1.1 MJ and is reserved for athletes of the Men Junior category.

The race is by INVITATION and participation is reserved for the teams provided for in article 2.1.005 of the UCI Regulations.

In accordance with the article 2.2.003 of the UCI regulations, teams shall be composed of a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 6 riders.

No points will be awarded according to UCI regulations for the UCI 1.1 MJ ranking.

For any participation indemnity (board, lodging, expense reimbursement), the terms set out in the engagement bulletin shall apply.

Art.3 – Approval documentation:

The race will be held on the route illustrated in the following attached documents:

- Elevation Profile;
- Race map;
- Time/Distance Schedule;
- Elevation profile, road map and description of the final three kilometers;
- Indication of vehicles deviation point at the finish;
- Declaration of acceptance from the Race Director and Deputy Race Director;
- Written communication detailing the location of hospitals or emergency medical service along the entire race;
- Map of the start and finish area, indicating the location of the: Commissaires' Panel, Anti-Doping Control, Secretariat, Press Room, Organizing Headquarters.

Art.4 - Registration:

Once participation is confirmed, the teams must confirm the entries of their riders using the engagement bulletin to the Organizer via email race@coppamontes.eu no later than 20 days before the start of the event.

The team, 72 hours before the race, must confirm the names of the starting riders and the reserves.

Art.5 – Race Headquarters / Secretariat :

Preliminary operations and verification of licenses, confirmation of attendance and distribution of race numbers will take place at the the I. S. I. S. School "Sandro Pertini" Via Valentinis 20, from 9:30am.

The license check and confirmation of the starters will take place on 25th of April from 9.30am to 11.15 am at the I.S.I.S. School "Sandro Pertini". At the finish, the location of the Headquarters and the Commissaires' Panel will be at the I. S. I. S. School "Sandro Pertini" Via Valentinis 21.

Art.6 - Team Managers' meeting:

According to the article 1.2.087 of the UCI regulations, the technical meeting with the Race Director, the Commissaires' Panel, the Sports Directors and the FCI STF Representative (if present) will be held on the 25th April 2026 at 11.30 am at the I. S. I. S. School "Sandro Pertini" Via Valentinis 20.

Art.7 - Race security meeting:

The meeting between Safety Manager, Race Directors, Commissaires' Panel, Police, Motorbike Security, Neutral Technical Assistance service, Medical staff, Photographers and the TV Operators involved in the circulation of the race convoy, will be held at the end of the Technical Meeting at the I. S. I. S. "Sandro Pertini" school Via Valentinis 20.

Art.8 - Starting point / team presentation:

Riders must go with their entire team to the public presentation of the teams which will take place from 12.50 PM in the immediate vicinity of the starting area in via Don Ferdinando Tonzar. The unofficial departure will take place from via Valentinis at 1.50 pm with a controlled speed transfer to Staranzano, (km zero) where the official departure will be given at 2.00 pm.

Art.9 - Radio Tour:

A race information service "Radio Tour" will be provided. All vehicles following the race must be in mandatory possession of an approved receiver apparatus, capable of receiving information and instructions which will be broadcast in Italian, French or English. Frequency: VHF 161.8875

Art.10 - Neutral technical assistance:

The mechanical assistance service will be provided by G.S. Cicli Barone with 3 neutral cars, duly equipped, as required by the UCI regulations. The wheel or bicycle change can also be done by the official team vehicle following the race and by riders of the same team. No motorcycle assistance is authorized.

Art.11 – Level crossing:

For any level crossings, which must be indicated on the timetables, the provisions of the UCI regulations apply.

Art. 12 – Feeding:

Feeding is permitted starting from 30 kilometers from the start and up to 20 kilometers from the finish, both by persons on foot (exclusively in the designated feeding zones at km 35,4 and km 82.3) and by authorized vehicles following the race, in compliance with the provisions of Articles 2.3.025, 2.3.025bis, and 2.3.027 of the UCI Regulations.

Art.13 – Ecology:

According to the ecological campaign advocated by the UCI, and in order to avoid littering the environment, participants are urged to act responsibly and not throw waste along the road, but to dispose of it within the "Green Zones" located near the feeding zones at km 35.4 and km 82.3. Additionally, there will be a third green zone at km 113.5, as indicated by specific signage, where a designated company will be responsible for the collection.

Art. 14 – Time limit:

Pursuant to Article 2.3.039 of the UCI Regulations, the time limit is set at 8% of the winner's time. The time limit will be increased by the Panel of Commissaires, in the presence of exceptional circumstances, after consultation with the organizer.

Art.15 - Classification:

In addition to the individual final classification, the following Intermediate Sprints (TV) and KOM Prizes (GPM) are set:

For each Intermediate Sprint, the first two riders will be prizes.

For each KOM, the first three riders will be awarded. Additionally, the top three riders in the overall points classification will be awarded, with points assigned as follows: 1st place – 5 points, 2nd place – 3 points, 3rd place – 1 point.

In the event of a tie, the best placement at the finish line will determine the winner.

Art. 16 – Prizes:

The prizes will be paid at the end of the race according to the national tables for the top 20 classified. The prizes will be subject to the tax provisions in force in Italy. Any extra-ranking prizes will be brought to the attention of the athletes with a specific communication before the start of the race. The payment of the prizes will be made directly on site at the end of the race.

Art.17 - Anti-doping control:

Any anti-doping control will be carried out in conformity with the current UCI regulations. It will take place at I. S. I. S. School "Sandro Pertini" Via Valentinis 20. Furthermore, an anti-doping control may also be carried out by the Italian State authorities in accordance with the relevant Italian legislation.

Art.18 – Awards Ceremony:

As per Article 1.2.113 of the UCI Regulations, the first 3 classified riders must present themselves at the ceremony, within 10 minutes of finishing the race in the duly indicated space.

Art.19 – Penalties:

The applicable sanctions are those provided for by the UCI Regulations.

Art.20 – Medical Service:

The Medical Service will be provided by three ambulances by “Croce Verde Goriziana” and a medical car with two doctors on board. The hospital plan along the road race is:

Art.21 - Highway code - Liability:

The riders and the drivers of all officially accredited vehicles accompanying the race are required to strictly observe the Highway Code and the instructions issued by the Race Director. The Sports Director is responsible for the athletes and team members officially communicated to the organization at the time of accreditation. The event will be opened and closed by cars bearing the signs “INIZIO GARA CICLISTICA” and “FINE GARA CICLISTICA”.

Art. 22 – Commissaires’ Panel:

The Panel of Commissaires is composed as per the attached specification.

Art.23 - Reference Rules:

For any matters not specifically covered, the Panel of Commissaires will apply the UCI Regulations and the laws of the Italian State insofar as they are applicable.
